

# SEA ANEMONE

## Yarn and Hook Size

**You will need 3 yarn colors of your choice (A, B, & C)**  
4 mm hook.

(you can use any size hook that works with your chosen yarn)

## Stitches

The pattern is written in US terms.

The abbreviations are as follows:

CH – chain;

SL ST – slip stitch;

SC - single crochet;

INC - 2 SC in the same stitch;

DEC - SC decrease. I use the invisible SC decrease (insert hook into front loop only of next two stitches, draw up a loop through both stitches (two loops on hook), draw a loop through both loops on hook);

FLO - work into the front loop only;

BLO - work into the back loop only.

## Notes

The anemone is worked in continuous rounds, except where the pattern specifically states to join the end of a round. It is made in two parts, with a separate base which is sewn on after stuffing the main piece.

This pattern uses the invisible join. If you haven't used this before, have a look at [my quick guide here](#).

The anemone starts with a magic circle.

## Pattern

### Start with YARN A

Start with a magic circle.



Row 1: 6 SC into magic circle, join with a slip stitch and ch 1 (6)

Row 2: [SC, INC] around (9)

Row 3: SC around (9)

Row 4: SC around (9)

Row 5: FLO [2 SC, INC] around (12)

Row 6: [SC, INC] around (18)

Row 7: [2 SC, INC] around (24)

Cut yarn, and finish with an invisible join.

### **Change color to YARN B:**

Row 8: Join the new yarn with a SL ST into the FLO of the first stitch in row 7, then - [ch 9, skip first ch, then SL ST back along ch (8 SL ST), SL ST into FLO of next two stitches] repeat the steps in [ ] 11 more times (12 petals), join with SL ST into first ch of first petal and ch 1

Row 9: (work these stitches into the BLO of row 7) [3 SC, INC] around (30)

Row 10: repeat Row 8, to make 15 petals

Row 11: (work these stitches into the BLO of row 9) [4 SC, INC] around (36)

Row 12: repeat Row 8, with ch of 10, to make 18 petals, but don't join with SL ST

Cut yarn, and finish with an invisible join into the first ch of the first petal.

### **Change color to YARN C:**

Row 13: (work these stitches into the BLO of row 11) [5 SC, INC] around (42)

Row 14: repeat Row 8, with ch of 11, to make 21 petals

Row 15: BLO [5 SC, DEC] around (36)

Row 16: [4 SC, DEC] around (30)

Row 17: SC around (30)

Row 18: SC around (30)

Row 19: SC around (30)

Row 20: SC around (30)

Row 21: [4 SC, INC] around (36)  
Row 22: SC around (36)  
Row 23: SC around (36)  
Row 24: [5 SC, INC] around (42)  
Row 25: FLO [SC around] (42)  
Row 26: 2 SC, then [2 INC, 2 SC] 10 times (62)  
Cut yarn, and finish with an invisible join.

With **YARN B**, use a tapestry needle to sew spots on the stem.

To make the base, use **YARN C**

Start with a magic circle.

Row 1: 6 SC into magic circle, join with a slip stitch and ch 1 (6)  
Row 2: INC around (12)  
Row 3: [SC, INC] around (18)  
Row 4: [2 SC, INC] around (24)  
Row 5: [3 SC, INC] around (30)  
Row 6: [4 SC, INC] around (36)

Cut yarn, and finish with an invisible join.

Stuff the main piece, then sew the base to the BLO of row 24. Sew every 6th stitch of the base to two stitches of row 24.
